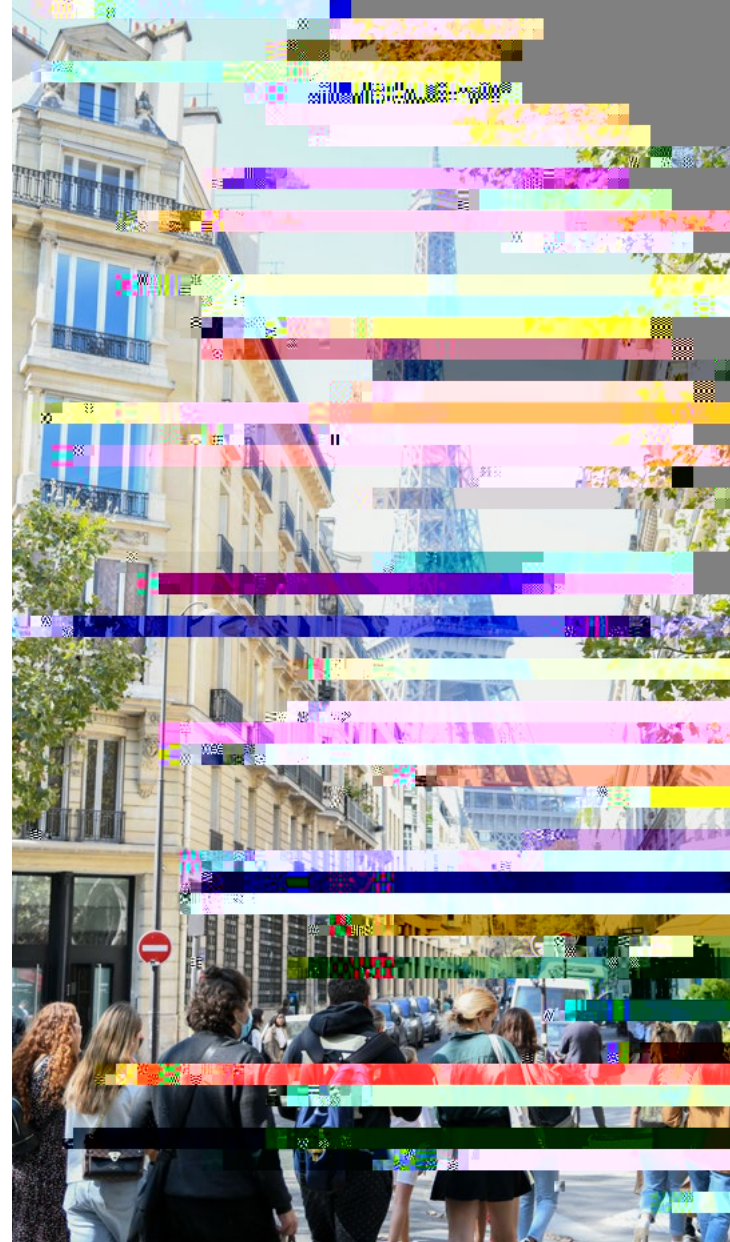

How to Apply

Our application process is simple and straightforward: just submit your information, upload your supporting documents, and we'll send you an admission decision. If you are currently completing your high school education, you'll apply to AUP as a first-year student. If you have 12 or more college credits, you'll apply as a transfer student. We review completed applications in multiple rounds throughout the year, though you're encouraged to apply early as priority for admission and scholarships is awarded in earlier rounds.

To apply, please submit the following materials:

- Completed online application form at [p. d / pp](https://p.d/pp)
- Personal statement
- Supplemental essay
- Extracurricular and work experience
- Transcripts for the last three years of school
- Two letters of recommendation
- English language test result *if English is not your school language of instruction*
- €50 application fee *or \$50 if using the Common Application*

We accept applications on a continuous basis throughout the year in alignment with the varying academic schedules of our international applicants.
